Participation Points:	2 points are awarded to each complete bowling team of 6 players
Fundraising Points:	1 point is awarded for each bowler raising the minimum \$150.00 1 point is awarded for every \$100 over the \$150 minimum that each bowler raises
Team Points:	10 points are awarded for every \$1,000 a team raises

Final Calculations

Individual bowler scores are added together to determine each Team's Score, and Team scores are totalled together to determine the Overall Score.
